Dear Parent.

Year 8 Religious Studies Visit to Neasden and High Wycombe Tuesday 8 and Wednesday 9 November

We would like to include your daughter on an educational visit:

- to BAPS Shri Swaminarayan Mandir Hindu temple in Neasden, London and the Jamia Masjid Mosque and All Saints Church in High Wycombe
- on Tuesday 8 November for Learning Groups 8A, 8B and 8C
- on Wednesday 9 November for Learning Groups 8D, 8E and 8F
- from 8.50 am till 3.40 pm
- to experience a variety of different religious communities, as part of an integral unit of work.

Your daughter should arrive at school at the normal time of 8.45 am in full school uniform, including footwear. She should register in The Forum at 8.50 am. Your daughter is required to wear trousers for this visit. If she does not have regulation school trousers, she may wear a pair of plain black / dark-coloured trousers (no denim, leggings or jeggings please). She will need to bring a scarf to cover her head and a packed lunch.

Please note that the organisers may wish to take photographs or videos of the event for publicity purposes.

As the visit takes place within school hours no charge can be made by the school for the visit. May I therefore invite you to make a contribution of £6.50 to cover the costs involved. Please be aware that if there are insufficient contributions the visit will not be able to take place.


You can make your contribution using ParentPay (www.parentpay.com), our online payment system, choosing the service 'Year 8 RS Visit'. As part of the online payment process you will be asked to give your consent to your daughter's participation in the visit. There is then no need to return the reply slip below.

Alternatively you can send a cheque for £6.50 made payable to Wycombe High School Fund with the reply slip below, in an envelope, to the Finance Office by **Wednesday 19 October**. Please write your daughter's name, tutor group, learning group and 'Year 8 RS Visit' on the envelope and on the back of the cheque.

The deadline for you to give your consent by either method is **Wednesday 19 October**. In the event that this deadline is not met, please be aware that your daughter may therefore not be able to participate in the visit; in such a case she will, of course, be attending school as usual that day. May we also draw your attention to the school's behaviour policy that applies to all educational visits, a copy of which can be found on the school website.

We would appreciate the assistance of any parents who may be able to join us on this visit. If you are free on the date on which your daughter's learning group is taking part in this visit, and you would like to help with general supervision of the girls, please indicate this on the reply slip below and return it, even if you have paid using ParentPay. We will contact you if we are able to take up your offer of assistance.
